Karen L. Miller, PhD, is Senior Vice Chancellor for Academic and Student Affairs at the University of Kansas Medical Center. She is Dean and Professor of the KU Schools of Nursing and Allied Health. Prior to her Dean's appointment, Dr. Miller was Vice President of Nursing and Clinical Services at The Children's Hospital, Denver, and Associate Professor at the University of Colorado Health Sciences Center. Dr. Miller has over thirty years of health care executive experience.

Dr. Miller completed her baccalaureate degree at Case Western Reserve University and her Master's and Doctoral degrees from the University of Colorado. Her research has been in the areas of health systems, finance and patient care outcomes in health care. Throughout her career, she has published and presented on organizational leadership in health care, financial management of clinical services and nursing workforce issues. In addition, she has written about the impact of gender on executive leadership in nursing. She is President of KU HealthPartners, a direct clinical services corporation for nursing and allied health professionals.

Among past national appointments, Dr. Miller has been a member of the Commission on Workforce for Hospitals & Health Systems of the American Hospital Association. She is active in the National Association of Schools of Allied Health and the American Association of Colleges of Nursing. Dr. Miller served a four-year term on the National Advisory Council on Nurse Education and Practice of the U.S. Department of Health and Human Services and she has served on the National Advisory Council of the National Institute of Nursing Research of the National Institutes of Health (NIH). Last year she was President of the Board of the Friends of the National Institute of Nursing Research. Dr. Miller was named a fellow of the American Academy of Nursing in 1995.
