This award was established by Dr. Kelly Johnson, Lecturer in the Biology Dept., to honor his wife Terri, who died of breast cancer in 2005. Terri was Development Director for KU Endowment and proud mother of a daughter and two sons. Following her diagnosis, she became a tireless advocate, speaker and educator to raise awareness about breast cancer. To apply, interested individuals should send a letter to etwrc@ku.edu indicating why they are a good candidate and include an academic progress report. Letters should be a minimum of 400 words but should not exceed 1,000 words. To be eligible, applicants need to be:

- A full-time female student
- Undergraduate or graduate status
- In a CLAS program/department
- A parent
- Particular consideration is given to candidates who demonstrate need and plan on applying their academics to make a difference in the world.

Amount: up to \$1,500. (possibility of renewal)

Application deadline: October 31, 2015, 5 p.m.
