BLOOMFIELD HILLS -- A funeral mass for Patricia Ann Wolfe, a former concrete company president, will be celebrated at 11 a.m. today in the Church of St. Owen, 6869 Franklin, in Bloomfield Hills.

Mrs. Wolfe, 66, of Bloomfield Hills died Thursday, Nov. 9, 2000, in Texas.

The Detroit native was president of the Concrete Mix & Supply Co. in Detroit. Founded by her parents, it was sold in 1986. She then concentrated her time on helping her children with their business endeavors.
